Holy Week 2019

Reconciliation (April 16 @ 6 p.m.) The Sacrament of Reconciliation and Absolution will be given during our normal Tuesday Mass. This Sacrament is a wonderful opportunity to let go and ask for forgiveness for our sins before being revived at Easter.

Holy Thursday (April 18th @ 6 p.m.) Holy Thursday is the start of the Sacred Triduum (3 Days). During this Mass we celebrate the commemoration of the Last Supper of Jesus Christ, when He established the Sacrament of Holy Communion prior to his arrest and crucifixion. It also commemorates His institution of the priesthood. During this Mass we will receive the Holy Oils blessed at the Cathedral that morning and the rededication to ministry of the clergy, religious and lay ministers.

Good Friday (April 19th 12 noon-3 p.m.) We will have a service that remembers Jesus' death. While there are no Masses on Good Friday, we will have a service that will include Stations of the Cross, Scriptures, Prayers for the Church/World, Veneration of the Cross, the Sacrament of Reconciliation and a Communion Service.

Holy Saturday — Easter Vigil (April 20th @ 5:00 p.m.) This is the most Sacred Mass of the Christian Calendar when we celebrate Christ's triumphant victory over the grave. This Mass includes the blessing of the new fire and water and the welcoming of new members into the Body of Christ through Baptism.

Easter Sunday (April 21st) Masses will be held at 6 a.m., 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. Come celebrate Christ's Triumphant Victory over the grave
