BLACK CATHOLIC HISTORY MONTH! DID YOU KNOW!



Did you know that Marjorie Gabriel Burrow a Parish Musician at St. Augustine-St. Monica Parish was the only female Associate Director of Black Catholic Ministries and the only woman who helped to bring the first African American Catholic Hymnal into existence?

In 1984 under the leadership of Archbishop James P. Lyke, Marjorie's efforts along with those of two other musical giants—Rawn Harbor and Leon Roberts—produced the first African American Hymnal, LEAD ME, GUIDE ME: THE AFRICAN AMERICAN CATHOLIC HYMNAL, that was published in 1987 by GIA publications. The Preface to the Hymnal contains the following accolade and I

quote: "However, a special word of appreciation must be given to Marjorie Gabriel-Burrow (chairperson) and Rawn Harbor and Leon Roberts, who as a Sub-Committee devoted untold hours, including vacation times, and incalculable energies to the study, selections and even composition and arrangement of the hymns. In all this, Mrs. Burrow was a great collaborator and organizer. To state it pointedly, without this gifted and dedicated trio, there would be no African American Catholic Hymnal."

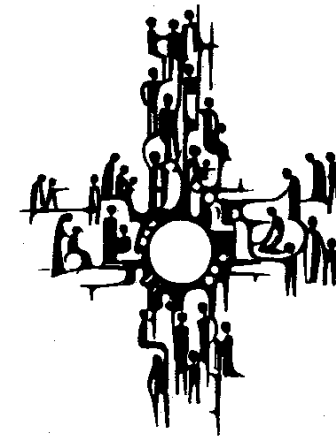
