Celebrating Black Catholic History Month



St. Josephine Bakhita - Born in southern Sudan in 1869 Josephine was kidnapped, stolen from her parents at the age of 7 and sold into slavery. After being sold multiple times she was given the name Bakhita 'Favored/Blessed'. She was forced to walk barefoot over 600 miles having been raped multiple times and her body mutilated. It was said of her fourth owner, a Turkish General, was so cruel to her that, *"During all the years I stayed in that house, I do not recall a day that passed without some wound or other. When a wound from the whip began to heal, other blows would pour down on me."* In 1885 she was taken to Italy and given to a man named Augusto Michieli. She was a

babysitter to the daughter Mimmina Michieli and would often accompany her to her religious instruction sessions run by Canossian Sisters. Josephine had an encounter with God in her heart, and that would change her life forever, she was baptized and confirmed in 1890. Upon return of the Michieli's from a stay in Africa they wanted to take Josephine back with them yet she refused to go. There was an ensuing court case and the final ruling was issued that slavery was illegal in Italy and she had actually been free since 1885. The Canossian Sisters had advocated for Josephine and she would later enter and make her first profession in 1896. She was so grateful for the instruction of The Canossian Sisters, she said, *"Those holy mothers instructed me with a heroic patience and introduced me to that God who from my childhood I had felt in my heart without knowing who He was."*
