At age 15, Anne Marie Becraft founded the nation's first Catholic school for free black girls, Georgetown Seminary, on Dumbarton Street in Washington, D.C. With an average enrollment of 30-35 students, Georgetown Seminary welcomed both boarders and day students. Becraft led the school until 1831, when she became the 11th black woman to join the Oblate Sisters of Providence and subsequently renamed herself Sister Mary Aloysius. She taught at the school established in 1828 by the Oblate Sisters, Saint Frances Academy in Baltimore, which today remains the oldest continuously operating predominantly African American high school in the United States.

In 2017, Anne Marie Becraft re-emerged as a historic figure when Georgetown University renamed Rev. William McSherry Hall, which honored a Jesuit enslaver involved in the selling of 272 enslaved people to benefit the University in 1838, to Anne Marie Becraft Hall.
