
...COVID Testing Sites. We are experiencing an unprecedented 4th surge of COVID-19 in our state to that end the city has two sites for getting tested for COVID-19. The City of Detroit is expanding its capacity for COVID-19 rapid testing to 1,000 appointments per day with the addition of a second location, TCF/Huntington Place (One Washington Blvd.), for those who live or work in Detroit. TCF/Huntington Place is open for rapid antigen testing Monday – Friday, 9 AM – 5 PM. The move comes amid a sharp rise in COVID-19 cases statewide caused by the Omicron variant.

Rapid molecular tests continue to be available at the City's Joseph Walker Williams Rec Center site (8431 Rosa Parks Blvd.), from Monday – Friday, 7 AM – 4:30 PM. Appointments are required for testing at both sites and may be scheduled by calling 313-230-0505.
