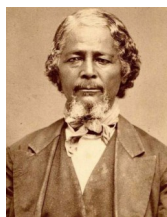

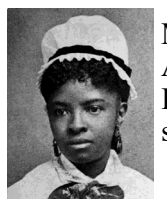
CELEBRATING
BLACK HISTORY MONTH



Benjamin "Pap" Singleton was an American activist and businessman best known for his role in establishing African American settlements in Kansas. A former slave from Tennessee who escaped to freedom in Ontario, Canada in 1846, he soon returned to the United States, settling for a period in Detroit, Michigan. He became a noted abolitionist, community leader, and spokesman for African-American civil rights.



Claudette Colvin is an American pioneer of the 1950s civil rights movement and retired nurse aide. On March 2, 1955, she was arrested at the age of 15 in Montgomery, Alabama, for refusing to give up her seat to a white woman on a crowded, segregated bus. This occurred nine months before the more widely known incident in which Rosa Parks, secretary of the local chapter of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, helped spark the 1955 Montgomery bus boycott.



Mary Eliza Mahoney (May 7, 1845 – January 4, 1926) was the first African American to study and work as a professionally trained nurse in the United States. In 1879, Mahoney was the first African American to graduate from an American school of nursing

...**FREE Tax Help.** Families and individuals with incomes up to \$57,000 may be eligible for free tax help with the Accounting Aid Society. If you pay rent, heating bills or property taxes and are not working but have other income, you may also still be eligible for some tax credits, such as a heat credit and a property tax credit. The Accounting Aid Society is currently scheduling appointments for 2021 tax returns only. You can schedule your appointment [online](#) or call (313) 556-1920.
