Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter.

During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.

...Good Time Initiative Petition Signing. Sacred Heart & DCPA's Community Action Committee are joining Michigan United and with thousands throughout the state, to collect signatures to place the Good Time Initiative on the ballot. Michigan is one of only six states with no policy for Good Time or Earned Time Credits. Thousands of incarcerated people face harsh sentences and deserve a second chance. The Good Time Ballot Initiative gives them a second chance by reducing the time served based on the inmate's good behavior. The Good Time initiative will task the Michigan Department of Corrections with developing rules for disciplinary time and earned credits, and create a board to review earned credits and prisoner records. The measure would repeal Michigan's Truth in Sentencing law, a prison rules change approved by voters in 1998 that repealed "good time credits" and imposed a mandatory minimum sentence that could be extended for misconduct.
