The Good Time initiative will task the Michigan Department of Corrections with developing rules for disciplinary time and earned credits, and create a board to review earned credits and prisoner records. The measure would repeal Michigan's Truth in Sentencing law, a prison rules change approved by voters in 1998 that repealed "good time credits" and imposed a mandatory minimum sentence that could be extended for misconduct.
